Centralized admissions to different Medical and Dental colleges in Rajasthan for the session 2014-15 shall be made in the following courses:

1. Bachelor of Medicine; Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)

The duration of MBBS course is 4½ years followed by internship of one year.

2. Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS)

The course is divided into 4 years of training and 1 year compulsory rotatory internship.

APPLICATION FEE

All candidates have to pay non-refundable application fee of Rs. 1500/- (Rs. 750 for SC, ST, PH category) through bank challan at any branch of Oriental Bank of Commerce.

The application fee is neither refundable, nor transferable and nor adjustable for any future RPMT. Any plea in this matter shall not be entertained.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Educational Qualification

No candidate shall be allowed to be admitted to the MBBS or BDS course until he or she has passed the qualifying examination as under:

Note: Where the Course content is not as prescribed for 10+2 educational structure of the National Committee, the candidate will have to undergo period of one year Pre-Professional training before admission to Medical Colleges. The Pre-Professional Course may be conducted either at a Medical College or a Science College.

Provided also that in case of admission on the basis of competitive entrance examinations, a candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry & Biology / Biotechnology at the qualifying examination and in addition must have come in the merit list as a result of such competitive entrance examination by securing not less than 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology taken together in the competitive examination. In respect of candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Special Backward Classes the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology / Biotechnology taken together in qualifying examination and competitive entrance examination be 40% instead of 50% as stated above. Further, for persons with locomotors disability of lower limbs, the minimum of 45% marks for General PH and 40% marks for SC-PH/ST-PH/OBC-PH/SBC-PH are required.

Provided further that a candidate who has appeared in the qualifying examination, the result of which has not been declared is to be provisionally permitted to take up the RPMT 2014 and in case of selection for admission to the MBBS/BDS Course, he/ she shall not be admitted in that course until he/ she holds the eligibility criteria on the date of the allotment.

2. Age limit

Minimum 17 years on or before 31st December 2014, i.e., born on or before 01-01-1998.

3. Other eligibility criteria

- I. The candidate has studied for the last three years of qualifying examination continuously as a regular candidate in a recognized institution in Rajasthan and is an Indian National.
- II. Natural father/Mother of the candidate has continuously resided in Rajasthan for period of last 10 years and the candidate has studied for at least 5 years during this period in a recognized educational institution in Rajasthan.
- III. All those students who are bonafide residents of Rajasthan but are studying in other states will also be eligible for appearing at RPMT-2014.
- IV. The candidate is son/daughter of serving or retired (i) Employee of Government of Rajasthan (ii) Officer of All Indian Services borne on State Cadres of Rajasthan and has served for more than three years with State Government.

- V. The candidate is son/daughter of serving or retired, permanent employee of Govt. Undertaking/ Corporation/Improvement Trust/ Municipal Bodies/ Council/ Panchayat Samiti/ Co-operative bodies, duly constituted by the Government of Rajasthan by an act of Law who has put in at least three years of service on the last date of submission of application in the year of admission.
- VI. The candidate is son/daughter of serving/retired, permanent employee of any of the State University or Secondary Board of Education (Rajasthan) provided that employee has worked in Rajasthan for three years preceding the last date of submission of the application.
- VII. Candidate is a natural son/daughter of a Serving/Retired permanent employee of Indian Defense and the employee is of Rajasthan origin irrespective of his place of posting. Provided that in case of Defense Personnel from Rajasthan origin, a certificate has to be submitted by them from Sainik Kalyan Board to the effect that his state of origin is Rajasthan at the time of his entry into service. Eligible candidates of this category shall be admitted as per laid down criteria of priority cum merit of the RPMT-2014.
- VIII. Candidate is a natural son/daughter of a Serving permanent employee of Indian Defense and the employee is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of submission of the application for admission.
- IX. Candidate is a son/daughter of serving/Retired person of Para-Military Forces of India and the employee is of Rajasthan origin, irrespective of his place of posting. Provided that in case of Para-Military personal from the Rajasthan origin, a certificate (certificate proforma 3) has to be submitted by them from the employer to the effect that his state of origin is Rajasthan at the time of his entry into service.
- X. Candidate is a son/daughter of serving person of Para-Military Forces of India and the employee is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of submission of the application for admission. (*certificate proforma 4*)
- XI. Candidate is a Son/Daughter of a Judge of Rajasthan High Court subject to the condition that he/she submits an undertaking/affidavit stating that such benefit is not being claimed or availed by them in any other State.

4. Reservation

- (a) 15% of the seats in Govt. Colleges will be reserved in MBBS/BDS Course to be filled up on all India basis conducted by DGHS / by the agency of Govt. of India.
- (b) Out of total 24 Seats, 4 in each State Medical College of Rajasthan of MBBS Course will be reserved for candidates selected under the Central Government pool. The Central Government Authority will fill up these seats.

Note: - The remaining seats shall be treated as the State Seats and will be filled up on merit cumpreference in RPMT-2014 with following reservations: -

- (c) (i) 16% seats, after excluding the seats of sub- clause (a), (b) above are reserved for natural born (not adopted) candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. 25% out of the above reserved seats shall be reserved for girl candidates belonging to Schedule Caste.
 - (ii) 12% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for natural born (not adopted) candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. 25% out of the above reserved seats

will be reserved for girl candidates belonging to Schedule Tribe. 45% of ST seats are to be for ST candidates who are bonafide residents of scheduled area (tribal area).

- (iii) 21% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for those belonging to Other Backward Classes as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. 25%, out of the above reserved seats shall be reserved for girl candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes.
- (iv) 1% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for those belonging to Special Backward Classes as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. 25%, out of the above reserved seats shall be reserved for girl candidates belonging to Special Backward Classes.
- (d) Six seats for MBBS and one seat for BDS out of the qualified candidates in the RPMT 2014 shall be reserved on priority cum merit for the natural born (not adopted) sons/daughters of Defence personnel (serving /Retired) of Rajasthan Origin. 50% out of these reserved seats shall be reserved for girls, unfilled seats will be revert back to boys category.

Two seats out of the qualified candidates in the RPMT 2014 shall be reserved on merit-cumpriority basis for the natural born (not adopted) sons/daughters of the Para Military personnel (Serving or Retired) of Rajasthan origin.

Priority order for Defence personnel of Rajasthan origin, in consultation with Director, State Soldier Welfare Board Rajasthan (Sainik Kalyan Board), will be as follows:- (attach certificate proforma 1 and 2)

- 1. Widows/Wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.
- 2. Wards of those Disabled in action and boarded out from service/died while in service with death attributable to military service / disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service.
- 3. Widows/Wards of Gallantry Award winners.
- 4. Widows/wards of ex-service men.
- (e) In case of private medical/ dental colleges, the reservation of seats will be according to the orders of the State government.
- (f) 3% seats out of each category of 16% SC, 12% ST, 21% OBC, 1% SBC and remaining General Category shall be further reserved on Merit-cum-Priority in each category horizontally for DISABLED candidates having permanent disability as per MCI and Govt. of Rajasthan rules. The Certificate regarding permanent Physical Disability including the percentage, issued by a Medical Board duly constituted at Govt. Medical College of State will only be considered (certificate proforma 5).

Note:

Persons with disabilities (Equal opportunities, Protection of Rights and full participation) Act, 1995 and notification No. S.O. 107 (a), dated February 7, 1996 issued from the Ministry of Welfare and published in Gazette of India, Ex.-Ordinary Part. II, Sec. 3(iii) dated 7-02-1996 page 1 by which under clause 2 of Chapter I definitions as (1) Disability means (i) Blindness; (ii) low vision; (iii) Leprosy cured; (iv) hearing impairment; (v) Locomotors disability; (vi) Mental retardation; (vii) Mental illness.

As per Medical Council of India vide No. MCI-34 (1)/ 2003/ Med/ 11773 dated 14-07-2003 and endorsed by Govt. of Rajasthan vide P-5/2 ME/Gr.-I/99 dated 30-07-2003 &P. 6(2) ME/I/2001 dated 18-01-2005 and MCI amended notification No. MCI- 34 (41)/ 2008 med./ 54469 date 25-03-2009:

- 1. the persons who are visually handicapped and hearing disabled should be deleted from this category and they should not be considered for admission in MBBS courses.
- 2. only persons with locomotors disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% should be allowed the benefit or reservation under the Disability Act for admission in the medicine courses. This condition shall apply to admission in all medicine courses for reserved seats.
 - Provided that in case any seat in this 3% quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates with locomotors disability between 50 to 70% then any such unfilled seat in this 3% quota shall be filled up by persons with locomotors disability of lower limits between 40 to 50% before they are included in the annual sanctioned seats for General Category candidates.
- 3. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than 3 months old from the date of submitting this application for seeking admission in the reserved category for disabled candidates.
- (g) The percentage of girl candidates shall not fall below 25% of the total seats (State) including the girl candidate admitted as per their merit in the general merit but excluding seats reserved under categories a and b.
- (h) The unfilled reserved seat(s) of any category from sub-clauses (a) to (f) shall be filled from the candidates of general category who fulfill prescribed conditions.

SEATS

RPMT-2014 will be conducted for 85% seats in Govt. Medical/Dental colleges of Rajasthan; and 85% seats in Private colleges who have opted to fill the seats in the respective colleges through RPMT-2014, as per the rules and regulations laid down by RUHS and Govt. of Rajasthan.

The total number of seats in Government / Private Medical and Dental Colleges will be finalized and notified by the time of allotment process.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Before filling the on-line application form, read the information booklet and instructions for filling on-line application form etc. very carefully. Ensure the eligibility and other requirements for admission as given in this booklet.

You should be very careful in filling-up the on-line application form. If any lapse is detected during the scrutiny, your candidature will be rejected even if you come through the final stage of admission process or even at a later stage.

IMPORTANT: HAND WRITTEN/TYPED/PHOTOSTAT COPIES/PRINTED APPLICATION FORM/SCREEN PRINTOUT WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.

Follow the steps as given in "Instructions to fill up on-line application form" available at the website.

Print copy of the application form

Print and preserve 2 copies of the application form filled on-line along with the following documents compulsorily with you:

- 2. Mark sheet of 10+2 (senior school certificate examination) or its equivalent
- 3. Date of Birth Certificate: 10^{th} class mark sheet / certificate or any other equivalent certificate showing the date of birth
- 4. Mark sheet of secondary examination (10th class)
- 5. Certificate of eligibility as selected by you (I to XI) as given under serial 3 in the information booklet
- 6. Copy of photo ID (driving licence / PAN card / Voter ID / Govt. or PSU card / School ID card / 12th class examination admit card / Aadhar card)
- 7. Caste certificate, sub-category certificate, if applicable
- 8. 4 Passport size photo same as affixed on application form
- 9. PH certificate, if applicable
- 10. WDP / WPP certificate, if applicable
- 11. Any other relevant certificate(s)

Candidates will be required to submit this print copy of the application form (duly completed in all respects) at the time of reporting to the allotted college, failing which their candidature shall be rejected/they will be disqualified without any further correspondence.

You should make sure of your eligibility etc. and that the declaration made by you in the format of application regarding your eligibility is correct in all respects. You will be liable to any legal action and / or punishment as may be deemed fit by the RUHS in case it is found that you have furnished in-correct information or made false declaration regarding your eligibility at any stage or suppressed any information.

The jurisdiction for legal cases arising out of RPMT-2014 shall be limited to the High Court of Rajasthan.

The decision of the RUHS in all aspects and all respects pertaining to the application and its acceptance or rejection as the case may be, conduct of RPMT-2014 and at all consequent stages culminating in the admission or otherwise of any candidate shall be final in all respects and binding on all concerned.

The RUHS reserves its right to alter and modify time and conditions laid down in the notification, information booklet for conducting the various stages up to the admission, duly intimating details thereof on the RUHS website, as warranted by any unforeseen circumstances arising during the course of this process, or as deemed necessary by the RUHS at any stage.

ADMISSION TEST

The computer based admission test is likely to be conducted on-line (at the examination center) on 28.05.2014, 29.05.2014 and 30.05.2014 in multiple sessions. The details of the admission test will be made available at RUHS website in due course. <u>Please refer to RUHS website regularly for latest update.</u>

The syllabus for the on-line examination is available at the RUHS website.

There shall be 200 objective type questions (50 questions each of 1. Physics, 2. Chemistry, 3. Botany & Zoology) of 4 marks each. Each question shall have four options to answer. There shall be no negative marking.

Admit card with relevant instructions shall not be sent by post and shall be available for downloading at the RUHS website.

All candidates are required to appear in the admission test at their own expenses. No TA/DA will be paid the purpose. The appearance in the admission test will not confer any right upon the candidate to be admitted to medical / dental course.

Candidates trying to use unfair means shall be disqualified from the admission. No correspondence whatsoever will be entertained from the candidates.

The RUHS reserves the right to create cities / centre(s) for RPMT-2014 and also to call the candidates for the RPMT-2014 at any city / centre., other than the one opted in the on-line application form.

ENTRY OF 10+2 RESULT

Entry of result of 10+2 or an equivalent examination

Candidates who are presently under "result awaited" category or are under "supplementary" category will be required to update their result at the RUHS website by the notified date, by entering through their login ID and password failing which their candidature shall stand cancelled.

SELECTION OF STUDENTS

The selection of students to a Medical College shall be based solely on the merit of the candidate through RPMT-2014 except for the candidates belonging to the categories of sub clause 'a' & 'b' of the clause-4 and reservation and priority-cum merit through RPMT-2014 for the category of the clause - 4 reservation.

The eligible passed candidates in the RPMT-2014 will be admitted in the order of merit for the general as well as reserved seats excepting the seats belonging to the category of the sub-clause 'd' of clause-4 in which case it would be priority- cum-merit.

Candidates securing equal marks in the RPMT-2014 will be admitted in the following order of preference:

- (a) One who has secured more marks in the science subjects of 10+2 or its equivalent qualifying examination.
- (b) One who has passed in lesser number of attempts.
- (c) One who has secured more marks in Secondary examination or its equivalent examination.
- (d) The candidate of higher age (older candidate).

Guidelines for PH candidates as per MCI guidelines

The Locomotor Disabled (LD) candidates are required to bring their treatment papers related to their disability, including the investigation reports, at the time of reporting to the medical board.

The candidate will have to get the certificate signed by the Medical Board for the purpose from the Govt. medical colleges of the state only. No other certificate signed by any other person will be accepted for eligibility for PH category seats.

The qualified locomotors disabled candidates of the qualified ranks announced in the RPMT-2014 result (to be published after the entrance examination) should get themselves certified at one of the Disability Boards constituted in Govt. Medical College of the state.

Guidelines for defence and paramilitary candidates as per MCI guidelines (WDP and WPP)

Candidates desirous of availing defence and paramilitary quota and who are declared qualified, shall be required to report for verification of certificates by the Admission Board on a specified date and time, at a specified place.

Guidelines for ST-STA (state tribal area) candidates as per MCI guidelines

Candidates belonging to ST-STA (state tribal area) who are declared qualified shall be required to report for verification of certificates by the Admission Board on a specified date and time, at a specified place.

ALLOTMENT OF SEATS THROUGH ON-LINE ALLOTMENT PROCESS: ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The allotments shall be made through on-line allotment process, of all successful candidates through RPMT-2014, strictly in accordance with merit list prepared on the basis of equivalent percentile score of the RPMT 2014 corresponding to minimum qualifying marks for all categories (as per RUHS ordinance) and the order of choices / options to be filled in by the candidates in the on-line form in due course.

For the alltment process and admission, separate instructions / guidelines will be provided to the candidates through newspapers / website etc. The decision of RUHS shall be final and binding to all. Candidates are advised to secure information regarding the admission from the website of RUHS (www.ruhsraj.org).

Reporting at the allotted college

After allotment of college and course, candidates will be informed about their allotment at RUHS website. Candidate is required to take a printout of the allotment letter using candidate login option and report at the allotted college with this printout alongwith requisite documents, in original, and prescribed fee, by the notified date.

The selected candidates must also carry all requisite certificates / documents in original along (with attested copies of the same) for verification, at the time of reporting at the allotted college, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. These original documents may be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

The colleges shall be provided the list of candidates allotted. The colleges shall verify the credentials of reporting candidates as per this list and check the documents and other required certificates with originals.

Last date of admission shall be September 30, 2014 as per Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment dated 11-09-2002. No admission can be given after 30 September 2014 even if any vacancies occur subsequently.

The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall stand cleared only after enrolment by the RUHS.

Medical Examination

The selected candidates will be required to undergo medical examination at the Institutions on the notified date(s).

Provided that if any candidate is not able to report for Medical Examination at the Institution on the notified date on medical grounds or due to some other circumstances beyond his/her control and his/her parent/guardian comes in person on his/her behalf for verification of the original certificates to the college he/she will be considered for provisional admission. His / Her formal admission will be confirmed only when he/she is found medically fit and fulfils other requirements before the date of commencement of the class.

Candidates who fail to attend medical examination on the notified date are liable to forfeit the claim for admission and will not be considered eligible for 2nd round.

All selected candidates will be examined by the Medical Board, appointed by the Principal of the respective Medical Colleges, at the Medical college allotted to the students on the basis of criteria evolved for the Medical examination by the Principal regarding their general and physical fitness. The candidates found unsuitable will be rejected. The decision of the Medical Board in this respect will be final.

Important:

The non-viewing of the RUHS website about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for non-reporting at the allotted college on the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled if he/she does not report IN PERSON to the allotted college as per the notified schedule.

For private medical and dental college one week time will be given for bank guarantee. If candidate does not deposit the amount of bank guarantee at the college within a week then the seat will be allotted to next candidate and 25% of fees will be forfeited and remaining amount will be returned to the candidate.

If at any stage, it is found that a non-eligible candidate is admitted to a course, then the admission of such a candidate will be cancelled on such detection. A penal action may also be initiated against such candidate.

The selection for this admission will be cancelled if the selected candidates do not report to join the classes on the stipulated date or whose particulars are not found correct or who are not found medically fit.

The candidates must present the accepted resignation from the intuition he/ she is pursing studies (at present) at the time of reporting. Failure to do so will result in disqualification for admission.

Impersonation

If at any stage, it is found that any candidate has indulged in any case of impersonation i.e. not matching the photograph/signature/videograph/documents of the candidates etc. he/she will be handed over to the Police and the cases will be dealt as per the Indian Penal Code in this matter and if required, the cases will be handed over to Police for further investigation. Such candidates will be debarred permanently from taking through RPMT, in future.

Conditions relating to bond/fee structure for BDS course

The candidates selected in Govt. Dental College (RUHS College of Dental Sciences) will have to submit a bond of Rs. 4.0 lacs (Rupees four lacs) in favour of Principal of the said college alongwith Bank Guarantee of Rs. 1.00 Lac, if the candidate leaves the course after 30th September 2014 the Bank Guarantee and Bond will be forfeited by the college.

The candidates admitted to private college will have to deposit fees as decided by the fee Regulation Committee formed by Govt. of Rajasthan for Private College, along with Bank Guarantee of (fees of 3 years) at the time of admission.

माननीय सर्वोच्च न्यायालय द्वारा पारित निर्णयों की अनुपालना में भारत सरकार/MCI द्वारा घोषित कलेण्डर के अनुसार 30 सितम्बर तक ही प्रवेश दिये जा सकते है। इसके बाद प्रवेश नहीं दिये जायेगें।

The apex court drew guidelines for the management of all educational institutions to follow. Among them:

Educational institutions should take anti-ragging measures right from the time of advertisement for admissions. The prospectus, the form for admission and/or any other literature issued to aspirants for admission must clearly mention that ragging is banned in the institution and anyone including in it is likely to be punished appropriately which may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology.

The punishment may also take the shape of: (i) withholding scholarships or other benefits (ii) debarring from representation in events (iii) withholding results (iv) suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess. If there be any legislation governing ragging or any provisions in statute/ordinance, it should be brought to the notice of the students/parents seeking admissions. A printed leaflet detailing when and to whom a victim may turn for information, help and guidance for various purposes, keeping in view the needs of new entrants, along with their addresses and telephone numbers should be given to fresher at the time of admissions so that they need not to look to seniors for help in such matters.
