PROMYS India is a partnership of PROMYS with Ashoka University. A challenging six-week summer programme, PROMYS India is designed to encourage mathematically talented secondary and higher secondary students to explore the creative world of mathematics.

PROMYS India is closely modelled on PROMYS (**Program in Mathematics for Young Scientists**), its 31-year-old parent programme at **Boston University in the U.S.** which has welcomed students from across the U.S. and around the world every summer since 1989. PROMYS Europe, another PROMYS offshoot, has been running very successfully at the **University of Oxford** since 2015.

Eligibility Criteria: Students must be in secondary or higher secondary school in Standards IX – XII (or +1, +2, or PUC). Students need to be at least 15 by the start of the programme.

Registration:

- Last date of online application: 01/03/2020
- No Registration Fees
- The application includes a challenging problem set, application form, recommendation from a mathematics teacher, and school mark sheet.

Selection Criteria:

Applicants being considered for admission will be interviewed, in English, by telephone, Skype or online chat + Following criteria considered for selection procedure:

- An applicant's solutions of challenging mathematical problems.
- Teacher recommendation
- Secondary school mark sheet (grade report or transcript) covering all years from Standard IX
 and above (from Standard VIII and above for students applying in Standard IX).
- · Application responses relating to interest in the programme.

Program Schedule: May 24 - July 4, 2020

Award: Every student accepted to PROMYS India in 2020 will be awarded a full scholarship which will cover all participation costs: tuition, housing, meals, approved travel, and any required books.
